

BARTENDER

Our bartenders are responsible for packing, loading, and setting up mobile bar service for events, providing bartending service for our concessions contracts, checking for proper legal identification before serving alcoholic beverages, preparing and serving alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages for guests in accordance with Chowgirls Catering's policies and standards, and breaking down, loading out & cleaning per Chowgirls training, standards, and procedures. Bartenders are responsible for compliance of all federal, state, and city liquor laws and internal policies. This position reports to the **Beverage Program Manager**.

JOB DUTIES:

- Prepares alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages for patrons
- Properly measures wine, spirit, and batch pours and follows cocktail recipes
- Works well in a team, and individually, at events and concessions
- Provides prompt and courteous service to all guests while maintaining a respectful and positive disposition
- Maintains professional standards of appearance, attendance, and punctuality
- Loads and unloads event equipment/food at Chowgirls Headquarters before and after event execution
- Able to follow instructions given by managers
- Displays confidence in carrying trays, plates, glassware, and more
- Prioritizes tasks, remains focused, and works independently and collaboratively
- Email access and literacy are necessary
- Thrives in a fast-paced environment
- Ability to lift 40 lbs. or more and able to stand for long period of time
- Access to reliable transportation is required, and a valid driver's license is preferred, but not required
- Must be at least 21 years of age
